

Terms and Conditions

On receipt of your booking form and deposit\payment we will reserve your fishing holiday and your booking is accepted for all people named on the booking form.

We will send you a confirmation e-mail and on the **SUBJECT** line you will have a booking reference number, it will look something like this **Smith 120611 B1**. (this number must be quoted by any members of your party when contacting us)

The completed booking must name all persons in your party and include the minim non-refund-able deposit of 50% per person as a part payment or full payment towards the fishing trip (do not include the food option this is paid in Euros on arrival).

The person signing the booking form confirms they are responsible for the booking and for ensuring all others in the party have read and understood the Fishing rules and these Terms & Conditions.

The balance of the trip must be paid on or before the date shown on the Confirmation E-mail. **NO REMINDER WILL BE SENT.**

If you book within 10 weeks of departure you must pay the total cost of your fishing at the time of booking.

If we do not receive full payment in accordance with the above requirement we reserve the right to cancel your booking, and you will forfeit your deposit made and be subject to a cancellation charge as though there had been a cancellation.

In the event you cancel your booking in writing from the person who signed the booking form the following cancellation charges will apply:

- 11 weeks or more - deposit
- 10 weeks or less - the total cost

The holiday is for the persons shown on the booking form only (please notify us of any changes).

No *pets unless otherwise agreed at the time of booking.
If agreed then owners must clean up after them.

Dads & Lads

This concession is only available for juveniles under the age of 16 at the start date of your trip. Proof of age on arrival may be asked for. 16 and over the

share a swim concession must be taken.

Mobile Home

The facilities of the mobile home are for the use **only** of those named persons shown on the booking form.

The mobile swim is now part of the mobile garden area and is in addition to your paid swim(s) on the long bank (or any other free swim on B2). Only guest that have paid to fish may fish this swim and only 1 swim can be fished at the same time.

* **No smoking in the mobile home** (An cleaning charge of €50 will be deducted from the deposit if you or anyone is seen smoking in it).

* No *pets in the mobile home (even if a pet has been agreed)

* No fishing tackle to be stored in the mobile home.

* No bait or feed to be stored in the fridge.

A £200 or 200 Euro breakage\cleaning deposit is required on arrival and refunded on day of departure provided the mobile home is in the same clean and tidy condition as when the hire commenced and no breakages.

Travel Documents

All passport, visa and health certificate requirements are your responsibility and we accept no responsibility for any delay or expense incurred if any of your documents are not in order.

British passport holders are advised that they should hold a full 10 year British passport with at least 3 months unexpired term beyond the travel date. Non British passport holders should check at their consulate for French visa requirements.

We advise all clients to have appropriate Travel/Holiday\Breakdown cover Insurance Policy in force for the period of the holiday and are advised to have an EHIC card.
